WHEREAS, employees of the County of Fresno (the "County") participate in the Fresno County Employees' Retirement Association ("FCERA") in accordance with the County Employees Retirement Law (the "CERL") as set forth in the California Government Code, and

WHEREAS, members of FCERA make mandatory employee contributions to FCERA and also may elect to redeposit member contributions plus interest previously withdrawn and elect to purchase additional service credit as provided in the CERL through additional contributions to FCERA, and

WHEREAS, under the Internal Revenue Code ("Code"), these member contributions to FCERA may be made on a pre-tax basis as pick ups in accordance with section 414(h)(2) of the Code, and

WHEREAS, if a member of FCERA elects to make contributions for redeposits or for the purchase of additional service credit on a tax pick up basis, this election must be made in accordance with a binding, irrevocable payroll deduction authorization, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a previous resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno dated March 26, 1985, any mandatory contribution made by employees to FCERA is irrevocably made on a pick up basis, and any election made by a member of FCERA to make contributions for redeposits or for the purchase of service credit on a tax pick up basis is made in accordance with a binding, irrevocable payroll deduction authorization, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the County and its employees to restate the prior resolution of the Board of Supervisors with respect to tax pick up contributions made by members of FCERA to make redeposits or purchase service credit

 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF FRESNO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 This resolution applies to all contributions that are required to be made by any employee of the County to the Fresno County Employees' Retirement Association ("FCERA") on a regular, payroll deduction basis in order to participate in FCERA and are made in accordance with the County Employees' Retirement Law ("CERL"). These member contributions to FCERA include normal contributions and COLA contributions and are called "mandatory employee contributions" in this resolution.

Section 2 This resolution also applies to all employee contributions made to FCERA for the purpose of purchasing service and/or redepositing amounts previously withdrawn plus interest pursuant to a binding irrevocable payroll deduction authorization made by the employee to have such contributions picked up for tax purposes and made on a pre-tax basis. These contributions to FCERA are called "elective employee contributions" in this resolution.

Section 3 All mandatory employee contributions made to FCERA, even though designated as employee contributions and even though deducted from the employees' compensation, shall be picked up by the County for tax purposes in accordance with section 414(h)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code and shall be treated as paid by the County to FCERA in lieu of the contributions made by the employee to FCERA.

Section 4 All elective employee contributions made to FCERA, even though designated as employee contributions and even though deducted from the employees' compensation, shall be picked up by the County for tax purposes in accordance with section 414(h)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code and therefore shall be treated as paid by the County to FCERA in lieu of the contributions made by the employee to FCERA. This section shall only apply if the employee executes a binding, irrevocable payroll deduction authorization to have these contributions picked up by the County in

accordance with section 414(h)(2) of the Code. Such authorization shall be made at the time, in the manner and on a form provided by the County or FCERA.

Section 6 All mandatory employee contributions and all elective employee contributions shall be paid from the same source as all other compensation is paid to employees of the County with respect to whom pick up contributions are made under section 414(h)(2) of the Code.

Section 7 No employee of the County shall have the option of choosing to receive mandatory employee contributions directly instead of having them paid by the County to FCERA as provided in this resolution.

Section 8 If the employee chooses to have elective employee contributions picked up by the County and executes an irrevocable, binding payroll deduction with respect to these contributions, the employee shall not have the option of choosing to receive these contributions directly instead of having them paid by the County to FCERA.

Section 9 This Resolution restates the previous resolution dated March 26, 1985 made by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno. It does not establish any new rules with respect to pick up contributions to FCERA.

WHEREAS, members of FCERA make mandatory contributions to FCERA in order to participate in this system ("mandatory contributions"), and also may elect to redeposit member contributions plus interest previously withdrawn, and elect to purchase additional service credit ("elective member contributions") as provided by the County Employees' Retirement Law through additional contributions to FCERA, and

WHEREAS, under the Internal Revenue Code ("Code"), these member contributions may be made on a pre tax basis as pick ups in accordance with section 414(h)(2) of the Code, and

WHEREAS, this system currently accepts pre tax mandatory and elective member contributions under Section 414(h)(2) of the Code, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the members of FCERA for this Board to restate its current rules with respect to mandatory and elective member contributions that are made on a pre tax pick up basis,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Retirement of the Fresno County Employees' Retirement Association as follows:

Section 1. This resolution establishes a regulation governing the operation of the Fresno County Employees' Retirement Association ("FCERA") in accordance with section 31525 of the Government Code.

Section 2. This resolution applies to all contributions that are required to be made by any member of FCERA on a regular, payroll deduction basis in order to participate in FCERA and are made in accordance with the County Employees' Retirement Law ("CERL").
