WHEREAS, the Fresno County Employees' Retirement Association ("FCERA") is the retirement system for the County of Fresno (the "County"), and for participating governmental employer entities (each a "Special District" or collectively, "Special Districts"), under the County Employees Retirement Law of 1937 ("CERL," Gov. Code, § 31450 *et seq.*) and the Public Employees' Pension Reform Act of 2013 ("PEPRA," Gov. Code § 7522 *et. seq.*); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Retirement of FCERA is the governing board of FCERA (the "Board of Retirement"); and

WHEREAS, the FCERA is committed to preserving and nurturing public access and participation in meetings of the Board of Retirement; and

WHEREAS, all meetings of the FCERA legislative bodies are open and public, as required by the Ralph M. Brown Act (Cal. Gov. Code 54950 – 54963), so that any member of the public may attend, participate, and watch FCERA's legislative bodies

conduct their business; and

WHEREAS, the Brown Act, Government Code section 54953(e), makes provisions for remote teleconferencing participation in meetings by members of a legislative body, without compliance with the requirements of Government Code section 54953(b)(3), subject to the existence of certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, a required condition is that a state of emergency is declared by the Governor pursuant to Government Code section 8625, proclaiming the existence of conditions of disaster or of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the state caused by conditions as described in Government Code section 8558; and

WHEREAS, a proclamation is made when there is an actual incident, threat of disaster, or extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the jurisdictions that are within Fresno County, caused by natural, technological, or human-caused disasters; and

WHEREAS, it is further required that state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing, or, the legislative body meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health and safety of attendees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Retirement previously adopted a Resolution on October 6, 2021, finding that the requisite conditions exist for the legislative bodies of FCERA to conduct remote teleconference meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of section 54953, as authorized by subdivision (e) of section 54953, and that such legislative bodies shall comply with the requirements to provide the public with access to the meetings as prescribed in paragraph (2) of subdivision (e) of section 54953, and desire to further adopt another such resolution; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of extending the use of the provisions found in section 54953(e), the Board of Retirement must reconsider the circumstances of the

state of emergency that exists in Fresno County, and the Board of Retirement has done so; and

WHEREAS, emergency conditions persist within Fresno County, specifically, by the Governor's Order N-21-21, the Governor has extended the order declaring a State of Emergency due to the impacts of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the County of Fresno continues to recommend social distancing to combat the imminent risk to the public health and safety due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Retirement does hereby find that the Governor's declared State of Emergency and the County's recommended social distancing has caused, and will continue to cause, conditions of peril to the safety of persons within Fresno County that are likely to be beyond the control of services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the agency, and desires to affirm a local emergency exists and re-ratify the proclamation of state of emergency by the Governor of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, as a consequence of the local emergency persisting, the Board of Retirement does hereby find that the legislative bodies of FCERA shall continue to conduct their meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Government Code section 54953, as authorized by subdivision (e) of section 54953, and that such legislative bodies shall continue to comply with the requirements to provide the public with access to the meetings as prescribed in paragraph (2) of subdivision (e) of section 54953; and

WHEREAS, FCERA shall ensure that the public has the opportunity to participate electronically, in real-time, in all 100% electronic meetings of the legislative bodies of FCERA during all public comment periods; and

WHEREAS, FCERA shall ensure that the public has the opportunity to participate in-person, in real-time, in all hybrid physical and electronic meetings of the legislative bodies of FCERA during all public comment periods, at 7772 N Palm Ave, Fresno, CA 93711 or other location as listed on the publicly posted agendas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Retirement of the Fresno County Employees' Retirement Association does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The Recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

SECTION 2. <u>Affirmation that Local Emergency Persists</u>. The Board of Retirement hereby considers the conditions of the state of emergency and acknowledges that a local emergency persists throughout Fresno County.

SECTION 3. Re-Ratification of Governor's Proclamation of a State of Emergency. The Board of Retirement hereby ratifies the Governor of the State of California's Proclamation of State of Emergency, effective as of its issuance date of November 10, 2021.

SECTION 4. Remote Teleconference Meetings. The FCERA staff and legislative bodies of FCERA are hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution including, continuing to conduct open and public meetings in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e) and other applicable provisions of the Brown Act.

SECTION 5. Effective Date of Resolution. This Resolution shall take effect on February 16, 2022 and shall be effective until the earlier of (i) March 18, 2022, or (ii) such time the Board of Retirement adopts a subsequent resolution in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e)(3) to extend, or end, the time during which the FCERA staff and legislative bodies of FCERA may continue to teleconference without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of section 54953.
